**Announcement of the Board of Investment**  
**No. Sor. 10/2547**  
**Re: Additional Rights and Benefits for Activities Related to the Production of**  
**Alternative Energy**

Whereas it is deemed appropriate to grant additional rights and benefits to businesses that produce alcohol or fuel from agricultural products, and production of electricity or steam power:

By virtue of Section 16, Paragraph 2, and Section 31, Paragraph 2, of the Investment Promotion Act of B.E. 2520, the Board of Investment hereby announces that the provisions under Section 1 and Section 7 of the list of activities eligible for investment promotion attached to the Board of Investment Announcement No. 2/2543, dated 1 August 2000, regarding types, sizes and conditions of activities eligible for promotion, shall be amended as follows:

1. Conditions of Activity 1.26 to be supplemented by the following provisions as Clause 2:

Activity	Conditions
1.26 Manufacture of alcohol or fuel from agricultural products	2. Classified as a priority activity of special importance and benefit to the country. The projects will not be subject to the cap on the amount of corporate income tax exemption specified in Paragraph 2 of Section 31.

2. Conditions of Activity 7.1 to be supplemented by the following provisions as Clause 5:

Activity	Conditions
7.1 Public utilities and basic services 7.1.1 Production of electricity or steam power	5. Classified as a priority activity of special importance and benefit to the country. The projects will not be subject to the cap on the amount of corporate income tax exemption specified in Paragraph 2 of Section 31.

Effective from 30 September 2004, onwards.
