AN ACT to amend the Customs Tariff Act 1975.

[04th July 2017]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Act 2017.
- (2) This Act commences on the date of assent.

2. Second Schedule amended:

The Second Schedule of the Principal Act is amended by substituting Code 120 as follows:

Concession is restricted to complete units and does not extend to spare part	As may be determined by the Comptroller".
