AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 11844 AND 11845 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO DESIGNATE THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AS A NATURAL ENERGY INSTITUTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 11844 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11844. Designation of Natural Energy The University of Guam is designated as the 'Guam Natural Energy Institute'."

Section 2. A new Section 11845 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11845. The Guam Natural Energy Institute: Duties; powers. The Institute shall:

(a) Maintain liaison with federal agencies (Natural Science Foundation, Energy Research and Development Administration, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Housing and Urban Development, Department of Transportation, and Department of Defense), the Government of Guam, the Guam Energy Office, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency and Department of Public Works and with other public and private natural energy-related projects in Guam; keep a current inventory of all such projects and work with the Guam Energy Office and other organizations to encourage coordination and cooperation in all energy-related research projects through the Territory.

Maintain a current file on all possible support programs (public and private) for awards and grants to both educational and energy-related research and development programs through the University and notify, provide assistance in proposal preparation, and follow-up with appropriate departments and

- (c) Maintain a clearinghouse of information on
 - (1) abstracts of pertinent publications;
 - (2) a card file on energy publications available in the University of Guam; and
 - (3) catalogs, lists of suppliers, and price lists on natural energy, off the shelf items such as solar collectors for water heating, windmills, solar photovoltaic systems, and waste
- (d) Provide as a public service, both in response to direct inquiry and especially through a public education program, information on natural energy systems that may or may not have possibilities for potential use
- (e) Initiate, develop, and coordinate the undertaking natural energy system development projects; provide some level of matching support to attract extramural funding for these projects; and provide support for equipment requests for graduate thesis projects and for

(f) After three (3) years of existence, submit a comprehensive report on the progress of the Guam Natural Energy Institute along with a plan for improvement, further development and experimentation, such plan to include funding proposals from federal, private and local sources."

Section 3. The University is directed to prepare a proposal for funding the institute from various federal sources.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any law, the University of Guam shall administer all funding, local and federal, for the Guam Natural Energy Institute in cooperation with the Guam Energy Office.
