BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS: Section 1. **Short Title** This Act may be cited as the Import Duties (MEC Exemption) Act, 2008. Section 2. Amendment **(1)** Section 206, subsections (3) and (4) of the Import Duties Act, 1989 are hereby amended to read as follows: §206. General exemptions

No import duty shall be levied on lubricating oil and diesel fuel oil imported by, for, or on (3) behalf of, or sold to the Kwajalein Atoll Joint Utility Resource, Inc. (KAJUR) solely for the purpose of power generation. If import duties have been paid by an original importer, and residual fuel oil or diesel oil is subsequently resold to KAJUR for the purpose of power generation, then the original importer shall be entitled to a refund of import duties previously paid on that residual fuel oil or diesel oil.
