The Powering Communities Program will provide \$10.2 million in grants to not-for-profit community organisations. This will help them to their reduce energy use, improve energy productivity and reduce emissions.

The grants will help eligible organisations to:


- upgrade equipment to reduce energy consumption
- undertake energy management activities and assessments, such as energy systems assessments and feasibility studies
- invest in energy monitoring and management systems
- invest in on-site renewable energy and solar-connected batteries.

Up to \$67,700 will be available to fund up to 12 projects in each federal electorate. The minimum grant amount is \$5,000 and the maximum is \$12,000.


