Preface

The Annual Report on Power Sector of the Kingdom of Cambodia, 2009 Edition is compiled from informations received from the licensees, MIME and other organizations in the power sector till the end of 2008. This report is for dissemination to the Royal Government, institutions, investors and public desirous to know about the present situation of the power sector of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

This report is compiled from information collected by EAC and information taken from licensees' annual summary report on their activities during the Year 2008. Till the end of year 2008, 218 licensed electricity service providers share about 98% of power market in the kingdom of Cambodia. Among them EDC, the distribution licensees, the licensees supplying electricity in provincial towns and other big towns manage the service well, and keep their operational records to the required level of quality. Most of the small licensees supplying electricity in rural areas, cannot manage their operation at the required level, causing many inaccuracies in their data record. However as the power market share of this group of licensees is small (less than 2%); this will not materially affect the overall accuracy of the data furnished in this report. However, EAC gives special attention to the collection of the data done by it from these licensees and trains them to record the required data correctly as the data is important in assessing the real situation of rural electrification.

Any comments or suggestions from Royal Government, institutions, investors or public are welcome and will be considered by EAC to publish more useful reports in future reflecting the actual situation of the sector.

EAC expects that this report will be a valuable document for the information on the power sector of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

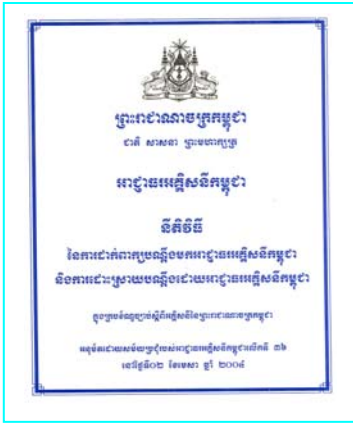

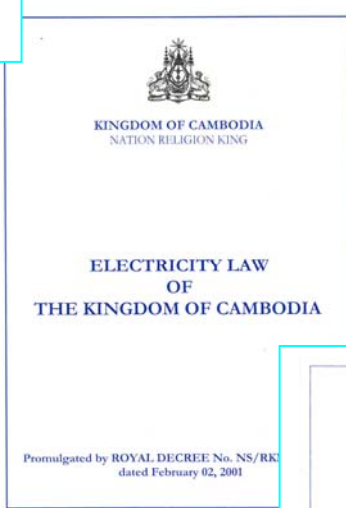
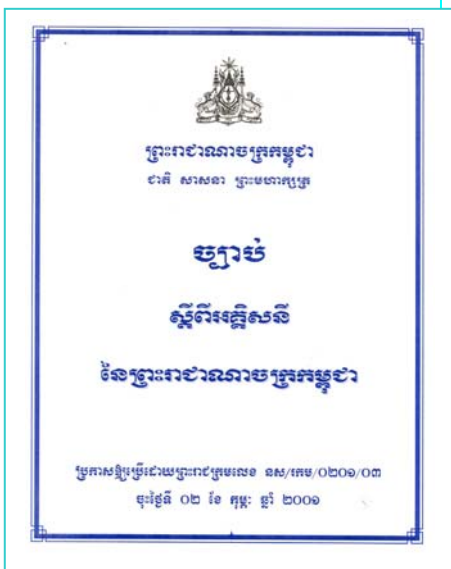

CHAPTER 1

Basic Law and Regulations in Power Sector Management in the Kingdom of Cambodia

1.1 Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia

Under the framework of reform in power sector, Royal Government of Cambodia has established the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia in order to open for and attract private investors to participate in the development of the power sector in the Kingdom of Cambodia. The Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia was adopted by National Assembly on November 06, 2000 at the plenary session No.5 of term 2, agreed by the Senate on the form and content of the law on December 13, 2000 at the plenary session No.4 of term 1 and announced to be consistent with the Constitution by the Constitutional Council on January 15, 2001. The Law was finally promulgated by ROYAL DECREE No. NS/RKM/0201/03 dated February 02, 2001 by Preah Bath Samdech **Preah Norodom Sihanouk**, King of Cambodia.

In preparation of a framework for the electric power supply and services throughout the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Law provides for the establishment of an institution called “Electricity Authority of Cambodia”, a legal public entity, being granted the right by the Royal Government to be an autonomous agency to regulate the power sector in the Kingdom of Cambodia.

The Electricity Law provides that the Electricity Authority of Cambodia shall consist of 3 Members, including the Chairman. The Chairman and Members shall be designated and proposed by the Prime Minister and shall be appointed by Royal KRET. Each Member shall have a 3 (three) years term, which shall be staggered so that the term of the initial members shall expire at different times.

As per the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia, “no person may operate as an electric power utility or provide electric power services unless he/she has performed under and in accordance with the terms of a valid license issued by the Authority. Any person, who is operating as an electric power utility at the time of promulgation of the Electricity Law, shall apply to the Electricity Authority of Cambodia for a license within 6 month of receiving the initial notice from the Authority”.

Regulations, orders and decisions issued by the Electricity Authority of Cambodia are enforceable as per the Electricity Law. Electricity Authority of Cambodia is competent to file complaints in the courts of the Kingdom of Cambodia for any violation of the Law or any violation of the regulations, orders, decisions as well as licenses issued by EAC.

The Law also provides for the rights, obligations and penalty on the service providers as well as the consumers in order to establish fair condition in the business and the use of electricity.

The enactment of the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia is a big leap forward in bringing reforms in the electricity sector. This reform will encourage the private investors to invest in the power sector in a fair, just and efficient manner for the benefit of our society.

1.2 Responsibilities of Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy and Electricity Authority of Cambodia in Power sector

Article 3 of the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia defines the responsibility of Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy and Electricity Authority of Cambodia separately. As per the provisions of this article, after EAC has started its operation, the governing of the power sector in the Kingdom of Cambodia shall be bifurcated, 1-the Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy shall be responsible for setting and administrating the government policies, strategies and planning in the power sector and 2-the Electricity Authority of Cambodia shall ensure that the provision of services and the use of electricity shall be performed efficiently, qualitatively, sustain ably and in a transparent manner.

It means that, the Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy, through its duty for setting and administering the government policies, strategies and planning in the power sector, is the institution of the Royal Government to chalk out the path that power sector of the Kingdom of Cambodia is going to take. This institution is also responsible for setting the technical standards for the power sector.

While EAC is responsible to issue rules, regulations and procedures and also is responsible to monitor, guide, coordinate including requiring the operators in power sectors both suppliers and consumers to follow the policy and guidelines and technical standards issued by Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy and ensure that the provision of services and the use of electricity shall be performed efficiently, qualitatively, sustain ably and in a transparent manner.

The roles of the two organization in governing power sector in the Kingdom of Cambodia as provided in the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia is shown in the following:

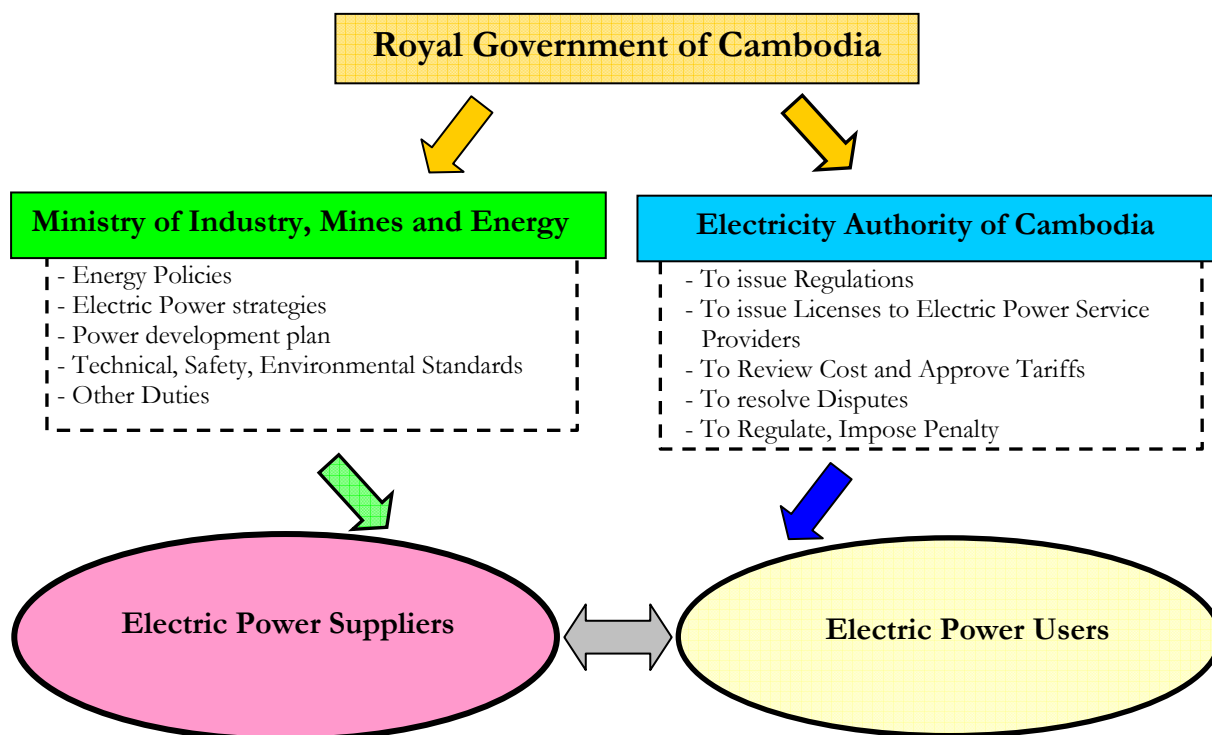


Figure 1: Separation of role between MIME and EAC

1.3 Duties of the Electricity Authority of Cambodia in the Power sector

1.3.1 Regulation of the Electric Power Services

Providing Electric Power Services mean the business of providing electric power services. Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia has granted the right and autonomy to EAC to regulate the activities of these services in order to ensure that the services and the business of the electric power service providers are actually carried out efficiently, qualitatively, sustainably and in a transparent manner. Granting the right and autonomy to EAC to regulate these services does not mean that Law has provided for EAC to get involved in or to manage the internal business of the electric power service providers. But it allows EAC to advise, guide or direct the service provider, to modify or cease such activity which affects the service being performed efficiently, qualitatively, sustainable and in a transparent manner. The guiding action or direction to revise or cease any activity is to be carried out in public interest and to protect the interest of the consumers.

1.3.2 Governance of the relation between the Delivery, Receiving and Use of Electricity

The relation between the Delivery, Receiving and Use of Electricity means the relation between generators and transmitters, between generators and distributors, between transmitters and distributors or between suppliers and consumers. These relations relate only to the cycle of delivery, receiving and use of electricity. The relations can cover the conditions of delivery and receiving electric power services between above parties; the obligations and rights of the above parties in delivery and receiving electric power services; the cost of electric power services that one party pays to the other party; the quality of electric power services that one party provides to other parties etc.

Electric Power Services mean services in electricity sector provided by one party to other parties. Electric power services does not only mean provision of **“Electricity”** by suppliers to the consumers or the generation, transmission or distribution services provided by one service provider to other service providers but can be any electricity work such as the installation of electrical equipments and network, operation and maintenance, the services in relation to providing the electric power services, the implementation of any work of electric power services etc., which one electric service provider delivers to other electric service providers or to consumers.

The Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia has granted the right and autonomy to EAC to govern these relations between the Delivery, Receiving and Use of Electricity.

1.3.3 Powers and Duties of Electricity Authority of Cambodia

According to the Article 7 of Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia, EAC has the following powers and duties:

- (a) To issue, revise, suspend, revoke or deny the licenses for the provision of electric power services as provided in article 29 of the Law;
- (b) To approve tariff rates and charges and terms and conditions of electric power services of licensees, except where the Authority consider those rates or charges and terms and conditions are established pursuant to a competitive, market-based process;

- (c) To enforce regulations, procedures and standards for investment programs by licensees;
- (d) To review the financial activities and corporate organization structure of licensees to the extent that these activities and organization directly affect the operation of the power sector and the efficiency of electricity supply;
- (e) To approve and enforce the performance standards for licensees;
- (f) To evaluate and resolve consumer complaints and contract disputes involving licensees, to the extent that the complaints and disputes relate to the violation of the conditions of license;
- (g) To approve and enforce a uniform system of accounts for all licensees;
- (h) To prepare and publish reports of power sector and relevant information received from licensees for the benefit of the Government and the public;
- (i) To prescribe fees applicable to licensees;
- (j) To determine the procedures for informing the public about its activities within its duties, in order to ensure that the Electricity Authority of Cambodia complies with the principle of transparency as set forth in Article 3 of this law;
- (k) To issue rules and regulations and to make appropriate orders, and to issue temporary and permanent injunction for electric power services;
- (l) To impose monetary penalty, disconnect power supply, suspend or revoke the license for the violations of this Law, standards and regulations of the Electricity Authority of Cambodia;
- (m) To require the electric power service providers and the consumers to obey the rules relating to the national energy security, economic, environmental and other Government policies;
- (n) To perform any other function incidental or consequential to any of the duties as describes above; and
- (o) To establish the terms and conditions of employment of the officers or employees including experts/advisors of Electricity Authority of Cambodia.

1.3.4 Legal Documents for Governing and Regulating Electric Power Services and use of Electricity

The Legal Documents for governing and regulating electric power services and use of electricity in the Kingdom of Cambodia are classified in Table 1 below:

Table 1: Legal Documents for Governing and Regulating Electric Power Services and use of Electricity

1 Law	The Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia and other Laws to manage and regulate the power sectors. Laws are main documents in regulating all activities in power sector and also the main base for preparation of other legal documents needed for managing and regulating the power sector.
2 Legal Documents of Government Class	Sub-Decree, Decision, Notification etc. of the Royal Government. These documents are for determining the power sector policy and for regulating the activities in power sector and are issued by the Royal Government under the provisions of the Electricity Law. CHAPTER 2
Information on Electricity Authority of Cambodia –
the Regulator for the Power Sector in the Kingdom of Cambodia

2.1 Regulator in Power Sector

According to the Electricity Law, the Electricity Authority of Cambodia (EAC) shall consist of 3 (three) members. The members of EAC shall be designated and proposed by the Prime Minister and shall be appointed by the Royal KRET. During the year 2008, the regulators for the power sector, appointed by the Royal KRET, are as follows:

1. **H.E. Dr. Ty Norin**, Chairman
2. **H.E. Yao Bunmeng**, First Vice-Chairman
3. **H.E. Dr. Sam Oeun Kim Hoeun**, Second Vice-Chairman

2.2 Organization of Electricity Authority of Cambodia

As provided by Electricity Law, EAC shall consist of three members and shall have one secretariat for assistance. This secretariat shall be headed by one Executive Director. The Executive Director shall be appointed by Chairman of EAC after consulting with other members.

At present, EAC has its organization structure as per the schematic diagram below. The highest authorities of EAC are the three regulators i.e. the chairman of EAC and the two vice-chairmen. Under the chairman and vice-chairmen, there is one secretariat headed by the executive director. Secretariat provides support to EAC for administrative and technical works and controlling the specialized departments under it. This secretariat consists of four departments for performing the works in their specialized fields separately and they are 1 – Department of Administration and Personnel, which is in charge of administration and personnel works; 2 – Department of Electricity Regulation, which is in charge of electricity technical works; 3 – Department of Financial and Pricing, which is in charge of financing, accounting and analyzing the electricity tariff works; and 4 – Department of Legislation, which is in charge of Legal works and resolution of dispute and imposition of fines.

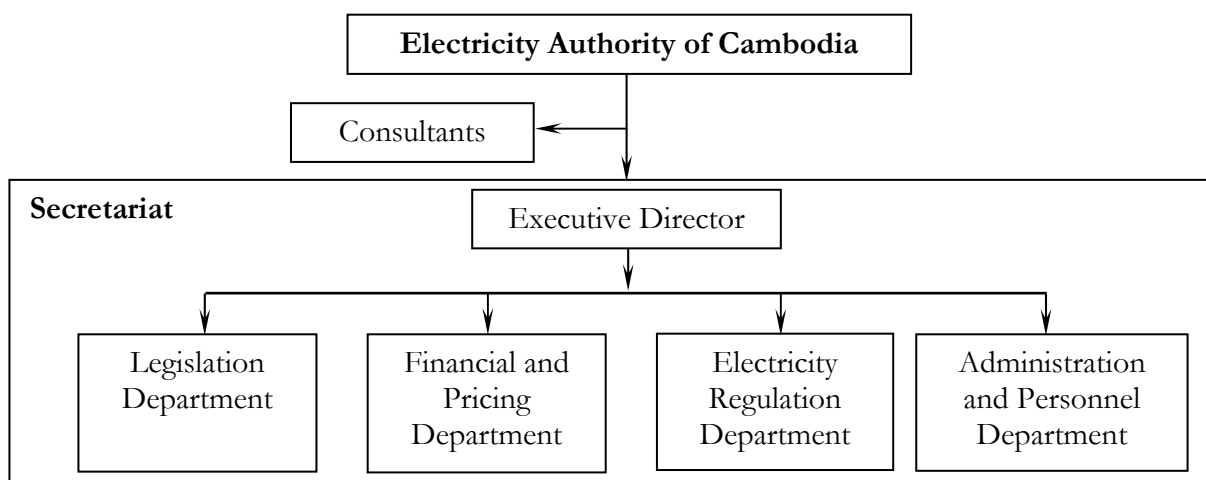


Figure 2: Organization chart of EAC

2.3 The Budget of EAC and License Fees

The Electricity Authority of Cambodia is an autonomous agency working for the interest of all electric power service providers and electricity users in the Kingdom of Cambodia. Therefore the expenditure of EAC for its operation is to be borne by all electric power service providers in the form of payment of license fees. Article 27 of the Electricity Law provides that EAC shall have an autonomous budget for its operation. This budget shall come through License Fees paid by applicants and licensees as determined by EAC. For governing the license fees charged by EAC, The Electricity Law has further provisions that “The maximum license fees are to be determined by a Sub-Decree of the Royal Government”.

Under the provisions of the Electricity Law of the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Royal Government have issued sub-decree No. 131-OR-N-KR/BK dated December 27, 2001 determining the maximum license fees applicable to the electric power service providers in the Kingdom of Cambodia.

According to Electricity Law, EAC shall determine the rate of the license fees to be paid by the licensees every year based on the maximum license fees determined by the sub-decree. For the year 2008, EAC has determined the license fees to be paid by licensees vide Notification No. 053SR-08-EAC dated February 25, 2008; which made no change in the License Fee of 2007. The license fees determined for the years 2006 to 2008 are given in Table 3 below.

2.4 Financial Statements of EAC

The Electricity Law provides that the annual financial statement, together with the accounting books of the Authority and related records shall be audited by auditor and inspected by the National Audit Authority. Within 1 (one) month after auditing, the Authority shall submit all reports to the Prime Minister for approval, and shall publish the approved reports to the public. The audited statement for the year 2008 is not available till now. The audited income statement of Electricity Authority of Cambodia for the years 2006 and 2007 is given below.

The Kingdom of Cambodia, a member country of the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN), with an area of 181,035 square Kilometers, is situated in the Lower Mekong region. Its neighboring countries are Thailand in the West, Vietnam in the East and Laos in the North. In Cambodia 80.5% of population live in rural areas where the rate of electrification is low. The rural electrification strategy sets the goal: by year 2020 all villages have access to electricity of at least one of different forms, including access to mini-grid and off-grid electricity. Potential of hydropower in Cambodia is high (more than 10,000 Megawatts) and has more certainty of development compared to other energy resources like petroleum and gas whose development is in the initial stages at present. To ensure a sustainable development of power sector Royal Government of Cambodia worked out an electrification master plan, which provides for (1) electricity generation development including hydropower resources development and development of coal or gas power plant, (2) electricity import to coordinate the development of the border zones of the Kingdom and (3) the development of transmission grid throughout the country in order to establish the electricity transmission system of Cambodia.

3.2 Developments in Power Sector till 2008

The planned stages of Power Sector Development in Cambodia are (1) to ensure sufficient, efficient and sustainable electricity supply through the isolated systems, with stress in development of systems in Phnom Penh City, and provincial towns, and (2) to start the construction of the skeleton transmission system of Kingdom of Cambodia and finally (3) to expand this power supply system to cover the whole country.

At this point we will describe the development of infrastructure to supply sustainable and quality electric power supply in isolated systems in different areas of Cambodia achieved till 2008. The development is divided in three parts as follow:

1. solution for Phnom Penh city,
2. solution for other cities, provincial towns and some main towns
3. solution for other areas

3.2.1 Interim Solution for Phnom Penh City

In Phnom Penh System power demand increased dramatically from 30 MW in 1995 to 240 MW in 2008, which means during last 13 years power demand in Phnom Penh city increased seven times. During this period the power supply areas extended not only to new areas within Phnom Penh, but also to nearby sub-urban areas including Kampong Speu provincial Town. Energy generation source is very important component in power supply system. Inadequate power generation capacity results in crisis in power supply service, which impacts not only the living standard of the society but also economic growth of the country. To ensure that Phnom Penh System has enough power generation capacity to meet the increasing demand, EDC constructed its

own power plants C3, C5 and C6 having an installed capacity of 46,000 kW and also contracted a number of IPPs to add further an installed capacity of 216,395 kW. On the other hand, the development of power generation capacity was only a part of the solution. In fact, the full solution of a sustainable and quality power supply included the development of distribution infrastructure also. EDC renovated the old system and also constructed new infrastructure at LV, MV and 115 kV to cover its area of supply, and to connect the generation plants.

3.2.2 Interim Solution for other cities and provincial towns

During last more than 13 years, apart from the effort to give sufficient power supply in Phnom Penh, MIME also gave special attention to implementing projects to give power supply in Provincial towns and main towns. From 1999 to 2008, MIME planned a large number of power supply development projects nation-wide and put them in operation through EDC and private entrepreneurs, using all possible type of investment such as loan, funds from bank, grant aid and concessions to private investment. As a result of these successfully implemented power projects, the power supply in provincial towns, cities, areas near the border, other areas and economic zones in Kingdom of Cambodia improved. These projects included installation of new generation plants at Shihanouk ville, Siem Reap, Takeo, Kampot, Banteay Meanchay, Preyveng, Steung Treng; contracting new IPPs where required, rehabilitation and extension of MV and LV System; Import from Thailand and Vietnam at more locations and extending the area of supply.

3.2.3 Interim Solution for rural areas

In addition to above mentioned power supply development projects for some cities and provincial towns, many other power infrastructure improvement project have been implemented in many places by small licensees who were issued licenses by Electricity Authority of Cambodia.

The licensees have taken action to improve their facilities following advice and suggestion from EAC in order to increase economic efficiency of their generation facilities and distribution facilities and on this basis have received right to provide electricity service for longer term. A large number of licensees have extended their area of supply and added MV lines to cover such larger areas or to improve the quality of supply.

3.2.4 Development of the Grid System

According to results of two studies, made under the framework of World Bank technical assistance (first study in year 2000 and second study in year 2006), the backbone transmission grid can be developed separately in two economic zones in Kingdom of Cambodia. The first zone is southern zone, consisting of Phnom Penh, Kandal, Kampong Speu, Takeo, Kampot and Shihanoukville. The second zone is Eastern zone, consisting of Banteay Meanchey, Battambang and Siem Reap provinces. The interconnection of these two zones will cover Kampong Chhnang and Pursat Provinces. Next two other areas, Kampong Cham and Steung Traing provinces, should be developed to facilitate the development of north-eastern zone. Development of the backbone transmission system should be started by construction of transmission line connecting all electricity markets in development areas and construction of National control Center and SCADA system to monitor the system, and expansion of sub-transmission system from sub-stations to provide electricity service from main grid to customers living in the surrounding areas. For providing adequate electricity to all these above cited areas, the strategy of generation development as an

interim measure is to import electricity from neighboring countries to provide electricity service to customer with affordable price and build the demand on the grid, and then construct big power plants in Cambodia with cheaper generation cost.

The Government of Cambodia has taken action to develop the Grid as per the studies stated above. The 115 kV Transmission System from Thailand border to Banteay Meanchey, Battambang and Siem Reap with Substations at Banteay Meanchey, Battambang and Siem Reap was commissioned in 2007. The work on construction of the grid in the Southern Zone is in progress.

3.3- Projects finalized and under implementation

The following power supply development plans are finalized and, at the end of 2008, are at different stages of implementation:

Project 1: Upgrading capacity of 115 kV systems in Phnom Penh

Scheduled Year of operation: 2009

Scope: 1) Add 2 circuit of 115 kV line from WPP substation to existing 115 kV system of Phnom Penh, 2) Add second circuit to the existing 115 kV line connecting substations in Phnom Penh, 3) Deviate 115 kV line from Kirirom Hydro Power Plant to WPP substation, 4) Modification of substation GS1 and connection of 10 MVAR reactive compensation on 22 kV side 5) Add one transformer 115/22kV 30/50 MVA at GS2 substation and connection of 15 MVAR reactive compensation on 22 kV side 6) Add one transformer 115/22 kV 30/50 MVA at GS3 substation and connection of 15 MVAR reactive compensation on 22 kV side. All these works are being done to upgrade transmission and distribution capacity of Phnom Penh power supply system and to receive electricity from Vietnam and new power plants.

Implementer: EDC under WB loan, Work in progress

Project 2: Construction of 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh, Takeo and Vietnam including substations at WPP and Takeo

Scheduled Year of operation: 2009

Scope: Build substations at West Phnom Penh (WPP) and Takeo and 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh to Takeo and to Vietnam in order to purchase electricity from Vietnam.

Implementer: EDC under ADB loan. Work in progress

Project 3: Construction of 22 kV sub-transmission lines in the provinces of Takeo, Phnom Penh, Kampong Speu, Kampot, Sihanouk ville and Battambang

Scheduled Year of operation: 2009, 2010, 2011

Scope: Construction of 22 kV sub-transmission lines in the provinces of Takeo, Phnom Penh, Kampong Speu, Kampot, Sihanouk ville and Battambang to take the grid supply to areas around the grid substations

Implementer: EDC under WB, ADB and other loans. Works in progress.

Project 4: Build National Dispatching Center

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build National Dispatching Center in Phnom Penh in order to manage all connected power supply systems in the country.

Implementer: EDC under WB loan. Bidding in progress

Project 5: Build 230 kV line connecting Takeo to Kampot and substation in Kampot provincial town

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Takeo and Kampot, and build 230 kV substation at Kampot provincial town in order to purchase electricity from Kamchay Hydro Power Plant.

Implementer: EDC, KFW give grant to RGC and RGC give this grant to EDC as loan to implement the project. Bidding in progress

Project 6: Build 230 kV line connecting Kampot to Sihanoukville and substation in Sihanoukville

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Kampot and Sihanoukville, and build 230 kV substation at Sihanoukville in order to purchase electricity from Coal Fired Power Plant.

Implementer: This project is under joint loan of ADB and JBIC and EDC is implementer of the project. Bidding in progress.

Project 7: Build 193 MW Kamchay Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting KHPP to Kampot substation

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build 193 MW Kamchay Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting this power plant to substation in Kampot provincial town in order to sell electricity to EDC.

Implementer: The investment for this project is by SINOHYDRO from People's Republic of China, who received special investment concession from RGC. Work in progress

Project 8: Build 18 MW Kirirom III Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting Kirirom III plant to Kirirom I substation

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build 18 MW Kirirom III Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting Kirirom III plant to Kirirom I substation in order to sell electricity to EDC.

Implementer: This project is the second phase of investment of Chinese company CETIC from People's Republic of China, who built Kirirom I Hydro Power Plant in the first phase. This project is in the same concession package with Kirirom I Hydro Power Plant. Work in progress

Project 9: Development of Stung Atay Hydro Power Plant, Common switching substation at Ou Saom and 230 kV transmission line connecting switching substation and Pursat substation.

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build 120 MW Stung Atay Hydro Power Plant, common switching substation, transmission line connecting this plant to common switching substation and 230 kV line connecting common switching substation to substation at Pursat provincial town.

Implementer: This project is under private investment and RGC gave concession to Yunnan Southeastasia Economy and Technology Investment Industrial Co Ltd from PRC in the project package Stung Atay Hydro Power Plant. Work in progress

Project 10: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh, Kampong Chhnang, Pursat and Battambang with substations at Kampong Chhnang, Pursat and Battambang

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh, Kampong Chhnang, Pursat and Battambang and build substations near Kampong Chhnang, Pursat and Battambang in order to connect southern zone system with western zone system to become one system.

Implementer: This project is under private investment and RGC gave concession to Yunnan Southeast Asia Economy and Technology Investment Industrial Co Ltd from PRC in the project package Stung Atay Hydro Power Plant.

Present Position: The Transmission agreement and IA have been signed. Preparation to start the work in progress

Project 11: Build 200 MW Coal Fired Power Plant in Sihanoukville and transmission line connecting this plant to Sihanoukville substation

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build 200 MW Coal Fired Power Plant (operated on imported coal) and transmission line connecting this plant to Sihanoukville substation.

Implementer: The investment for this project will be by a private company on the BOO basis.

Present Position: The PPA and IA have been signed.

Project 12: Build Stung Tatay Hydro Power Plant and transmission line to common switching substation.

Scheduled Operation year: 2013

Scope: Build 246 MW Stung Tatay Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting this plant to common switching substation.

Implementer: The Company China National Heavy Machinery Corporation from PRC will implement the project.

Present Position: The PPA and IA have been signed. Preparation to start the work in progress

Project 13: Build Lower Stung Russey Chrum Hydro Power Plant and transmission line to common switching substation.

Scheduled Operation year: 2014

Scope: Build 338 MW Lower Stung Russey Chrum Hydro Power Plant and transmission line connecting this plant to common switching substation.

Implementer: The Company Michelle Corporation from PRC will implement the project.

Present Position: The PPA and IA have been signed. Preparation to start the work in progress

3.4- Projects planned and under different stages of implementation

The following power supply development projects are planned and, at the end of 2008, are at different stages of planning:

Project 14: Build 115 kV line connecting Kampong Cham to Suong and Kraek towns and to Vietnam power system

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build 115 kV line connecting Kampong Cham, Suong, Kraek and Taininh in Vietnam and build 115 kV substations at 3 places, 1) in Kampong Cham provincial town, 2) in Suong town and 3) in Kraek town in order to import electricity from Vietnam to supply all above areas.

Implementer: This project is being undertaken in private sector.

Project 15: Build 115 kV line connecting Steung Treng to Laos's power system

Scheduled Operation year: 2011

Scope: Build 115 kV line connecting Steung Treng, Suong, to Lao power system and build 115 kV substation at Steung Treng provincial town in order to import electricity from Laos to supply Steung Treng province.

Implementer: This project is under grant of WB to RGC, and RGC is providing a loan to EDC to implement the project.

Project 16: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh to Kampong Cham and new grid substation in Kampong Cham provincial town

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build NPP sub station in Phnom Penh, and 230 kV transmission line connecting NPP to Kampong Cham provincial town and build substation in Kampong Cham provincial town in order to connect southern zone system with power supply system in Kampong Cham area together into one system.

Implementer: This project is being undertaken in private sector.

Project 17: Strengthen Phnom Penh System.

Scheduled Operation year: 2012

Scope: Build 115 kV substations in eastern area of Phnom Penh (EPP). Build 115 kV transmission line connecting GS1 to NPP and NPP to EPP to meet the load of new growing areas of Phnom Penh.

Study: This project is included in 2006 Master Plan but neither detail technical study nor the feasibility study has yet been done.

Implementer: EDC shall seek fund to implement this project.

Project 18: Upgrade capacity of Phnom Penh power supply system.

Scheduled Operation year: 2015

Scope: Build 230 kV part of EPP substation in Phnom Penh, upgrade transformer capacity in WPP substation, build new substation GS4 and 230 kV transmission line connecting WPP to GS4 and 230 kV transmission line connecting GS4 to EPP.

Study: This project is included in 2006 Master Plan but neither detail technical study nor the feasibility study has yet been done.

Implementer: EDC shall seek fund to implement this project.

Project 19: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting Phnom Penh to Sihanoukville substation

Scheduled Operation year: 2015

Scope: Build 230 kV transmission line connecting EPP substation in Phnom Penh to Sihanoukville in order to transport electricity from 400 MW Coal Fire Power Plant, which should be built in Sihanoukville.

Study: This project is included in 2006 Master Plan but neither detail technical study nor the feasibility study has yet been done.

Implementer: EDC shall seek fund to implement this project.

Chapter 4

Information on Licenses and Licensees in the Kingdom of Cambodia

CHAPTER 4

Information on Licenses and Licensees in the Kingdom of Cambodia

4.1 Licenses for Providing Electric Power Services

As per the provisions of the Electricity Law, each electricity service provider is required to have a license issued by EAC and to abide by the provisions of the Electricity Law, its license, and regulations and procedures issued by EAC. License for providing electric power services is an authorization document confirming to the provisions of the Electricity Law, which EAC decides to grant to an individual or legal entity to give it the right to provide electric services as per the provisions stated in the license (called the Conditions of License). A license has two main parts:

- a. Decision to grant the right to provide the electric power service, and
- b. Conditions of license.

Types of licenses that can be issued and regulated by EAC are stated below:

1. **The Generation License:** It grants the right to generate electric power from specified generation facilities.
2. **The Transmission License:** It grants the right to provide transmission service. There are 2 types of Transmission License: National Transmission License and Special Purpose Transmission License.
 - **The National Transmission License** can be issued only to state power transmission company which is under the Government control, to have the right to provide the transmission service for delivering the electric power to the distribution companies and bulk power consumers throughout the Kingdom of Cambodia
 - **The Special Purpose Transmission License** grants the right to construct, own, and operate specified transmission facilities in the Kingdom of Cambodia for the specified purpose.
3. **The Distribution License:** It grants the right to provide the electricity distribution services in a determined contiguous territory.
4. **The Consolidated License:** It is a license, which may be the combination of some or all types of licenses. The Consolidated License can be issued to EDC and to the isolated systems to grant the right to generate, transmit, dispatch, distribute and sale electric power to the consumers. Consolidate License can also be issued on consideration of long term planning and the objectives of Government policy to reduce long run marginal cost for supply of electricity to consumers, establish a national grid and progressively expand this grid throughout Kingdom of Cambodia.
5. **The Dispatch License:** It grants the right to control, manage, and operate the dispatch facilities for facilitating delivery and receiving electricity from the generation, transmission and distribution systems.

6. **The Bulk Sale License:** It grants the right to buy electricity from any Generation Licensee or from the power systems of neighboring countries for sale to Distribution Licensees or to large customers in one connected power system.
7. **The Retail License:** It grants the right to engage in the sale of electric power to consumers in a contiguous service territory.
8. **The Subcontract License:** It grants the right to provide electric power services according to the subcontract agreement with the existing licensee.

4.2 Licenses issued and revoked

The number of licenses issued, revoked and valid each year since 2002 is given in the Table below.

During 2008 EAC has issued 42 licenses, which is the highest after 2003. During this year two Consolidated Licenses consisting of Special Purpose Transmission License (for MV subtransmission) and Distribution were issued. These licenses allow operation of subtransmission lines for wheeling electricity to its distribution area and sale electricity to other licensees along the route of the subtransmission line.

During 2008, the supply from the Phnom Penh grid was extended to more licensees, as a result the type of license for Mr. Nget Hong (053L) and Mr. Heng Tray (071L) was changed from Consolidate to Distribution. The licensee, Electricity Unit of Mondulkiri Province (158L) added another area of Provincial Town of Mondul Kiri to its area of supply and added generation facility for this supply. Hence the type of license for it was changed from Distribution to Consolidate.

During 2008, 4 consolidate licensees transferred their licenses business to neighboring licensees due to which the licenses issued to them were revoked. The transfer of business was from Mr. Chou Sroan (065L) to Mrs Nhek Theary (056L), from Mr. Mok Chin (084L) and Mrs. Dik Rin (135L) to Mr. Chhin Seng (064L) and from Mrs Sok Kongkear to Phum Nimit Co. Ltd (189L). The list of licenses not valid by end of year 2008 is given in **Annex 7**.

Up to 31st December 2008, EAC has issued 234 licenses to the electric power service providers to grant the right to provide electric power services pursuant to the Electricity Law. Types and number of licenses issued during 2008 and licenses valid at the end of year 2008 are given in the Table below.

All the licensees except three are in the private sector. The three licensees in Government sector are (i) Electricite Du Cambodge – having Consolidate License No. 001L consisting of Generation, National Transmission and Distribution License, (ii) Electricity of Kratie Province – having Consolidate License No. 059L consisting of Generation and Distribution License, and (iii) Electricity Unit of Mondulkiri Province – having Consolidate License No. 158L consisting of Generation and Distribution License

Province wise area of supply served by Consolidated Licensees, Distribution Licensees and Retail Licensees and the normal hours of supply in these areas are given in **Annex 1**.

Maps of Provinces of Cambodia showing the location of the licensed area of supply and license number of licenses issued by EAC up to end of 2008 is given separately in this report.

4.3 Revision of Licenses

Licenses are revised from time to time as required for various reasons. 83 Licenses were revised during 2008. 42 licenses were revised for extension of their term. A licensee with infrastructure complying with technical standards and better operation and management gets a longer term for his license. As the licensees are improving their infrastructure, operation and management, year by year the number of licenses with longer terms is increasing. The Table below gives the number of Consolidated and Distribution Licenses having the same term at the end of 2006, 2007 and 2008. From the Table it can be seen that 128 Consolidated Licenses and 21 Distribution Licenses have got a term of 5 years or more.

During 2008, forty four licenses were revised to enlarge the licensed area of supply. During 2008 more licensees have enlarged the area of supply compared to earlier years; when in 2005 three licensees, in 2006 eleven licensees and in 2007 twenty six licensees had enlarged the area of supply.

During 2008, eight licenses were revised to add more generation capacity and fourteen licenses were revised as the existing licensee transferred the business to a new owner. Three licenses were revised to change the type of license and four licenses were revoked as they transferred their business to neighboring licensee.

4.4 Licenses in Operation during 2008

Out of 218 licenses valid at the end of 2008, fifteen licensees, as indicated in Annex 1 and Annex 3 had not started operation till the end of 2008. Out of the balance 203 licensees in operation at end of 2008, some licensees operate in more than one province. The number of different types of licensees operating in each province is given in the table below.

4.5 Efforts of Government of Cambodia, Rural Electrification Fund and EAC to assist licensees

During 2008, Electricity Authority of Cambodia and Rural Electrification Fund took effective steps to address the three identified problems of (i) lack of technical know-how (ii) lack of managerial know-how and (iii) lack of finance being faced by small licensees.

EAC organized basic level technical and management training for the managers and basic level technical training for the technicians of the licensees at three locations Phnom Penh, Skun and Banteay Meanchey. All licensees, engaged in distribution and supply, were invited to attend the training at one of the locations. The training was funded by Energy Sector Management Assistance Programme (ESMAP). The feedback from the trainees was very encouraging and the licensees were of the opinion that the training was very helpful and requested for more such trainings to be

arranged by EAC. During the annual licensee meet organized by EAC in December of 2008, the licensees were intimated about the importance and need of maintaining records of financial and technical data relating to their operation, evaluation of improvement made and situation of infrastructure of the licensees, implementation of the fuel-cost adjustment tables for tariff, and EDC plan of MV extension. The annual licensee meet provides an excellent opportunity of interaction among licensees and with EAC.

The Government of Cambodia has established Rural Electrification Fund (REF). REF has received funds from Government of Cambodia through loan from World Bank and grant from Global Environment Facility Trust Fund (GEF) to provide grant assistance to licensees for new connections to households and for installation of mini and micro hydro projects and renewable energy projects. By end of 2008, REF had disbursed grant assistance at the rate of US\$ 45 for each new connection to households for 14,314 new connections to 44 licensees. The details are given in the Table below.

4.6 Improvements in the operation of Electric Power Services

During 2008 also, the stress was on improvement and addition of MV lines and LV lines. The forty four licensees, whose area of supply was extended, began constructing MV lines and LV lines to cover the area of supply and achieve proper voltage regulation. MV lines were also constructed by the licensees who received supply from EDC grid. The existing LV lines were also improved by many licensees. Because of improvements done to infrastructure, out of 42 licensees whose term was extended during 2008, 33 licensees got a term of 5 years or more.

Chapter 5

Electricity Tariff of Licensees

CHAPTER 5

Electricity Tariff of Licensees

5.1 Electricity Tariff

The cost of electricity either from own generation or from purchase from IPP, neighboring country and other licensee is the single largest component of the cost of electric supply by licensees to the consumers. Almost 95% of the electricity generated by licensees in Cambodia use Diesel/HFO as fuel. Hence for the licensees generating electricity using Diesel/HFO or purchasing electricity from IPPs with cost of purchase linked to the price of fuel, the cost of electric supply is related to the cost of Diesel/HFO. During 2008, the cost of Diesel/HFO was high during the beginning of the year and reached a record high around June –July and then gradually declined at the end of the year to values lower than that in the beginning of the year. In order to quickly reflect the change in the cost of fuel in the tariff for consumers in a simple and transparent manner, EAC implemented Fuel Cost Adjustment (FCA) mechanism in the tariff of licensees. Under this mechanism, the tariff for different slab rates of fuel (diesel/HFO) is determined after public consultation, so that for only a change in the cost of fuel, the corresponding tariff could be fixed by EAC without the need of further public consultation. This process was implemented for some licensees in 2007 and for more licensees during the year 2008. The price fluctuation of fuel during 2008 was so wide that the range of slab rates for many licensees for whom the FCA mechanism was approved earlier, new range of slabs of fuel rates had to be added to cover the possible fluctuations in the fuel price.

The cost of generation from hydro power plant, purchases from neighboring country or from other licensees did not fluctuate much. Hence the tariff for licenses getting electric supply from such sources did not have frequent fluctuations and EAC approved the tariff without any price variation mechanism.

5.2 Electricity Tariff with Fuel Cost Adjustment Table approved by EAC

During 2008, EAC approved the tariff with Fuel Cost Adjustment table or tariff based on an approved Fuel Cost Adjustment table for the licensees given in the following Table.

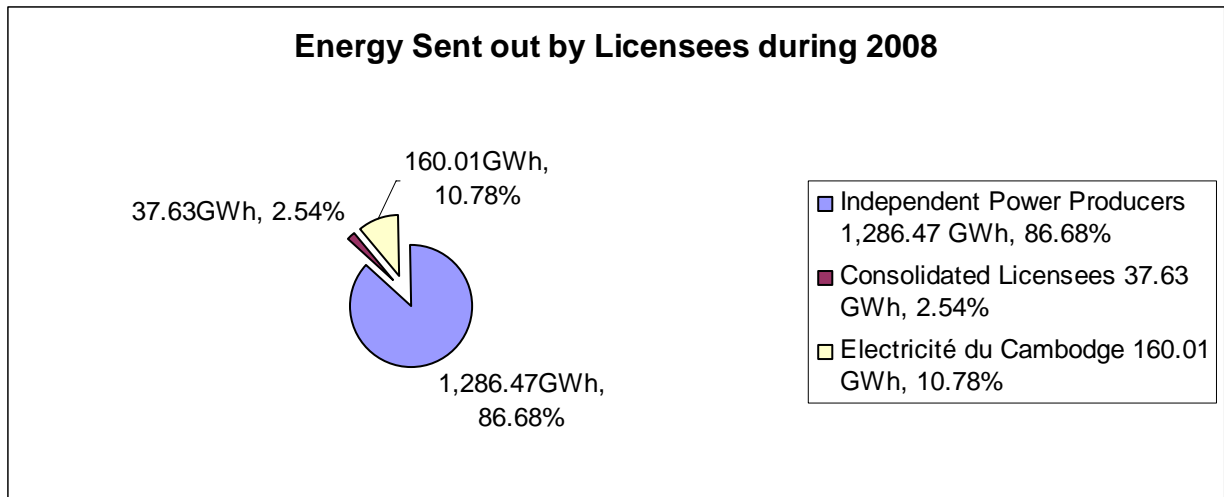
6.3 Generation in Cambodia

6.3.1 Generation by Type of License

Two types of licensees generate electricity in the Kingdom of Cambodia. Independent Power Producers, who have generation licenses, generate and sell electricity to suppliers or industries as per Power Purchase Agreement with that supplier or industry. And Consolidated Licensees generate electricity for supply to consumers through their distribution system.

The information on operation data of individual Generation Licensees, Electricite du Cambodge and Consolidated Licensees is given in **Annex 3**, **Annex 5** and **Annex 6** respectively. The summary information about installed capacity and energy sent out by the Independent Power Producers, EDC and Consolidated licensees is given in **Annex 2(a)**.

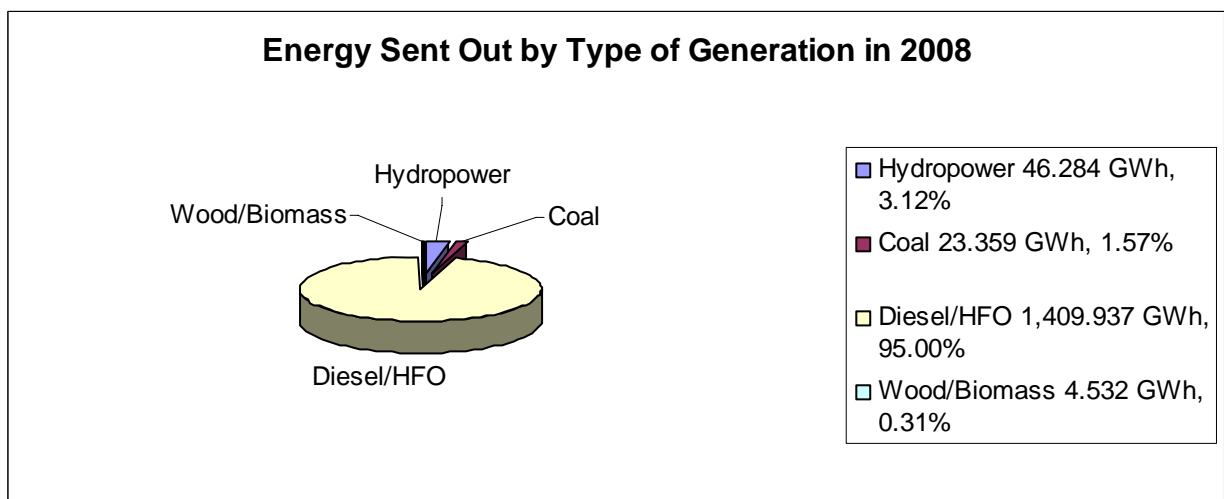
The quantum of energy sent-out by the Independent Power Producers, EDC and Consolidated licensees is shown in the graphic given below.



6.3.2 Generation by Type of Generation Facilities

For the year 2008, electricity generation facilities in the Kingdom of Cambodia can be divided into 4 types: 1 - Hydropower Plants, 2 - Diesel power Plants, 3- Thermal Power Plants using coal and 4 – Plants using wood and other biomass. There are four Hydropower Plants, 1. Kirirom connected to Phnom Penh power system, 2. Ratanakiri connected to Ratanakiri power system of EDC, 3. Mondulkiri supplying electricity to provincial town of Mondulkiri, and 4. Khum Koh Sampeay, Seambouk District, Steung Treng Province supplying electricity to the distribution area of Mr. Seang Savot having License No. 218L. Mr. Dung Ly, supplying electricity at Ang Long Tamey (Battambang Province), and SL Garment Processing (Cambodia) Ltd, supplying part of its generation to EDC Phnom Penh, use wood, agricultural products or waste as fuel for generation of electricity. Mrs. Touch Mantha, supplying electricity at Khum Phnom Sampov (Battambang Province) uses agricultural waste supplemented by diesel as fuel for generation of electricity. Sovanna Phum Investment Co., Ltd, an IPP, having License No. 213L, uses coal to generate electricity and supplies to EDC Phnom Penh. All other power plants of the licensees are diesel power plants using Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO) and Light Diesel Oil (LDO). The summary information on installed capacity and energy sent out by type of generation is given in **Annex 2(b)**.

The quantum of energy sent-out by the Independent Power Producers, EDC and Consolidated licensees classified by generation type is shown in the graphic given below.



6.4 Energy Imported from Neighboring Countries

As a result of the cooperation between the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Government of Thailand and the Government of Vietnam, Cambodia imports electricity from Thailand and Vietnam. Initially this import was only at MV (22 kV or 15 kV) but since November 2007, import from Thailand is also at 115 kV to supply to Banteay Meanchey, Battambang and Siem Reap provinces.

Based on the Electricity Trade Agreement between Ministry of Industry, Mines and Energy of Cambodia with the Ministry of Industry of Vietnam, government companies/organisations such as EDC, Electricity of Kratie and Electricity of Mondulhiri have signed Power Purchase Agreements with Vietnam Power No.2 for import of electricity at a number of points for supply of electricity to areas located near the Cambodia – Vietnam border either by them or through other licensees. Vietnam Power No.2 charges a fixed tariff of 6.9 US Cents per kWh for supply to Cambodia at MV.

Some private companies have received the right from MIME to purchase electricity from Provincial Electricity Authority of Thailand for supply to areas near Cambodia – Thai border. Cost of electricity imported from Thailand at 22 kV is as per the two parts – time of use tariff of Provincial Electricity Authority for the applicable category of consumer. The tariff has demand charges (Baht per kilowatt of maximum demand), energy charges (Baht per kWh with different rates for energy drawn during peak and off-peak hours), service charges (fixed charge as Baht per month), power factor penalty (Baht per excess KVAR) and Ft (change in expenses charge in Baht/kWh). Because of such tariff structure, the cost of electricity varies in different months due to different use conditions. The tariff for import by EDC at 115 kV from Thailand consists of fixed energy charge as Baht per kWh and Ft (change in expenses charge in Baht/kWh).

6.5 Electricity Transmission

6.5.1 High Voltage Transmission and Grid-Substation

By end of the year 2008, three high voltage lines were in operation: 115kV line around Phnom Penh, 115kV line from Kirirom 1 hydropower plant to Phnom Penh distribution system and 115 kV line from Thai border to Banteay Meanchey – Siem Reap and Battambang. Considering the purpose of utilization, the 115kV line around Phnom Penh is considered as operating for distribution services and 115kV transmission line transmitting electricity from Kirirom 1 hydropower plant to Phnom Penh's distribution system and 115kV transmission line

transmitting electricity from Thailand to Banteay Meanchey – Siem Reap and Battambang is considered as operating for transmitting electricity.

The summary information on High Voltage Transmission is given in Table 23 and on Grid-Substation is given in Table 24 below.

6.6.2 Energy Sold and Number of Consumers

Information on energy generated and purchased, energy sold to consumers, percentage of losses and number of consumers for groupings based on broad characteristics of operations is given in the Table below. The generation by Kampot Power Plant Co., Ltd is supplied directly to the industry of Kampot Cement co., Ltd and in this Table is included in the data on "Other Provincial Towns". Provincial Towns of Banteay Meanchey, Siem Reap and Battambang, which received supply from Thailand from November- December 2007, have been included in "North West Grid System". Provincial Town of Kampot, which received part electricity from Vietnam and part from own generation, has been included in "Areas getting supply from Vietnam".

The "Number of consumers" includes different types of consumers including residential, industrial, commercial, and offices. It is possible that in many cases, particularly in towns and cities, one consumer may serve more than one household. Hence the "Number of consumers" may not exactly show the number of house holds supplied with electricity. However, as indicative information, it is seen that the number of consumers is 17.21 % of number of households (2,832,691) as per provisional data of 2008 census.

As per provisional figures of 2008 census, the population of Cambodia is 13.389 million, and the per capita consumption of electricity supplied by licensees comes to 124.31 kWh per year during 2008.
